Code of ethics and professional conduct of the Society of Nepalese Health Professionals in Europe:

As a professional society, the Society of Nepalese Health Professionals in Europe embodies the highest aspirations of its members. This guideline shall serve to remind its members of the basic principles of ethical practices and the relevant standards of conduct that should guide their thoughts and actions while engaging in the organizational activities. The Society encourages all its members (in particular its Executive Board members) in practicing the high standards of professional conduct and ethics in order to reflect Society's principles of:

- 1. Integrity:** To behave in accordance with ethical principles and always act in good faith, intellectual honesty and fairness.
- 2. Accountability:** To take responsibility for one's actions, decisions and their consequences.
- 3. Independence and impartiality:** To conduct oneself with the interests of the Society under the authority of the Chairperson, and to ensure that personal views and convictions do not compromise ethical principles or the interests of the Society.
- 4. Respect:** To respect the dignity, worth, equality and privacy of all persons.
- 5. Professional Commitment:** To demonstrate a high level of professionalism and loyalty to the organization and objectives.
- 6. Role model in social media:** While using social media, act as a role model and think well before posting. You are responsible for what you publish. Never publish material that is obscene, racist, sexist, sexually exploitative or in any other way discriminatory, threatening or harassing, personally offensive, defamatory, or illegal.
